RESOLUTION # 12-07

RE: AMENDMENT TO 2012 FEE SCHEDULE WITH RESPECT TO SOLID WASTE HANDLING FACILITY PERMIT FEES

WHEREAS, Spokane Regional Health District is responsible for the adoption of regulations governing solid waste handling that implement the comprehensive solid waste management plan, including but not limited to the issuance of permits within Spokane County pursuant to RCW § 70.95.160; and

WHEREAS, Spokane Regional Health District may establish reasonable regulatory fees for the issuance of solid waste handling facility permits and renewal of solid waste handling facility permits pursuant to RCW § 70.95.180; and

WHEREAS, Spokane Regional Health District must review each solid waste handling facility for compliance with applicable rules and regulations prior to issuing or renewing a solid waste handling facility permit pursuant to RCW § 70.95.190; and

WHEREAS, part of the comprehensive solid waste management plan is enforcement of illegal dumping activities which results in an increased amount of solid waste through the permitted facilities both through deterrence and enforced clean up activities; and

WHEREAS, Spokane Regional Health District is authorized by RCW § 70.95.190(2) to establish reasonable regulatory fees for the review of permit applications for solid waste handling facilities; and

WHEREAS, such regulatory fees will be used solely for the funding of the solid waste management program at Spokane Regional Health District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health has directed that the solid waste program be full cost recovery; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Spokane Regional Health District's 2012 Fee Schedule adopted by the Board of Health, the applicable fee for the issuance or renewal of a solid waste handling facility permit is established as a set fee; and


WHEREAS, due to budget decreases there is insufficient revenue generated from the Coordinated Prevention Grant funds and permit fees to fund the cost of the program, it is necessary to add an additional regulatory fee of 32 cents per ton of solid waste received by the facility as reflected on the quarterly gate receipts of solid waste tonnage received. The amount of the regulatory fee is set at an amount necessary to fund that portion of the solid waste program not covered by CPG funds and permit fees, proportionately based on the amount of solid waste received by each facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SPOKANE REGIONAL HEALTH DISTRICT, that


1. The Spokane Regional Health District 2012 Fee Schedule with respect to Solid Waste Handling Facility Permits is hereby amended such that in addition to the annual fee for an initial solid waste handling facility permit or a renewal of a solid waste handling permit, a new fee of 32 cents per ton based on the quarterly gate receipts of solid waste tonnage received by that facility will be added to cover the enforcement and management of solid waste in Spokane County.
